## The Entrances of the port of Ashdod, Israel – Hertzal B – Sections No. D, H and I – Construction of Bridges, Roads and Utilities in the Ashdod Port Area

1. In accordance with the Mandatory Tenders Law 5752-1992, Israel Ports – Development and Assets Company Ltd. ("IPC" or "the Company") hereby invites bidders to take part in a tender for the construction of bridges, roads and utilities in the Ashdod Port area, Israel, as further detailed in the tender documents ("the Works", and "the Project", respectively).
2. The tender shall include two stages and shall be conducted as an Electronic Tender pursuant to regulation 19c of the Mandatory Tenders Regulations 1993, all as further detailed in the tender documents. Bidders shall ensure that the submission of their Bid shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of the Invitation to Bid and any applicable law, and that their Bid Bond shall be submitted to the designated Bid Bonds Tender Box as further detailed below, and not later than Bid Submission Date.
3. Bidders shall comply with the threshold requirements, as further detailed in the Invitation to Bid.
4. Bidders may download and review the Invitation to Bid from IPC's website at [www.israports.co.il](http://www.israports.co.il) under "Tenders". The full set of the Tender Documents shall be made available to Bidders which shall file a request to the following email: [D-H-I@israports.co.il](mailto:D-H-I@israports.co.il). Following receipt of a request, a username and password for the project site at <http://ramdor.net>, shall be emailed to the requesting Bidder. The email shall include instructions for downloading the Tender Documents from the project site.
5. The Bidder's response to the Invitation shall be submitted **no later than November 26th, 2018 at 12:00 (noon) Israel time**, in an electronic format to the IPC's Electronic Tender Box, at <https://ramdor.net>, except for the Tender Security, which shall be submitted to a designated Tender Box at IPC offices, 74 Menachem Begin Road, Tel Aviv, 12th floor, room no. 1207.
6. IPC may conduct negotiations with the Bidders and may choose not to conduct such negotiations, all in accordance with the provisions of the Invitation to Bid.
7. All terms used herein shall have the meaning ascribed to such terms in the Bidding Documents. The information provided hereinabove, is partial. Accordingly, Bidders are obliged to comply with all the provisions of the Bidding Documents in their entirety. In any event of contradiction between this notice and the contents of the Bidding Documents or information not included in the notice but included in the Bidding Documents - the contents of the Bidding Documents shall prevail over the content of this notice.
