- tunnelling and construction of the new single tube, double-track rail tunnel located on the 182+325.00 km of the Belgrade-Nis railway line,

- the scope of works includes all the necessary tunnelling and civil works, but not electrification, signalling and telecommunication which are part of Lot 2.

— construction of the tunnels 1, 2, 3 and 5 using the NATM design and construction method,

— construction of the emergency exit shafts for tunnel number 1 with two exist points on each side of the railway,

— the scope of works includes all the necessary tunnelling and civil works, electrification, signalling and telecommunication.
